Dear Parents and Guardians,

On 18th May 2020 the second phase of school reopening during the Corona crisis will take place and we will be able to see your child/children in the BJHS once again.

Special precautions must be taken, however. These will be hung up on the doors of the school. You will also find these hygiene rules at the end of this letter.

Your child will have the same timetable (without afternoon lessons) as before the crisis, but only on certain days of the week. The remaining days will be homework and practice days. Each school day will end at 1:55pm, whereby the classes will be dismissed in a staggered manner, to avoid large numbers of pupils leaving the building at the same time. If possible, avoid having your child use public transport.

Each class will be divided into two groups. Half the class (Group A) will have lessons at school on Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday. The other half (Group B) will be at school on Thursday and Friday. In the following week, the two groups will attend the other way around. This means that each pupil will have 5 consecutive days of attendance at school (split by a weekend), followed by five "homework" days. Wherever possible, these days should be spent at home. In most of the subjects there will be assignments to complete during these days. Support from teachers will be given via LMS, email and/or video conferencing via Teams.

The class teacher is responsible for dividing his/her class into the two groups. Pupils who have a brother or sister in the BJHS will all be in Group A. We cannot, however, start taking personal preferences (friendships, car-pooling) into account.

The class teacher will inform you and the pupils of the group placement in good time.

On homework days, we will be offering supervision for pupils who cannot stay at home or cannot do the homework at home. We kindly ask you to inform us in writing (office@bilingualeschule.at) one week in advance if you need to make use of this supervision at school.

Information concerning afternoon supervision and the two long weekends will follow as soon as we know more.

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Every pupil **must** wear a face mask on entering the school and it must be worn before, after and between lessons. **Masks cannot be provided by the school.**

Should your child be part of a high-risk group, or should you fear that your child, you yourself or any other family member is at risk of being infected, you may inform us in writing that you prefer your child not to addend school. In this case, however, you must ensure that your child can study at home.

Hygiene precautions at the BJHS from 18th May 2020 until further notice

In front of and in the entrance area of the school:

- Controlled entry \rightarrow not everyone at the same time; entry possible from 7:20am
- Keep your distance! (minimum 1 meter)
- Face masks must be worn.
- Parents and accompanying people may only enter the school building by appointment
- After entry: put on your slippers and wash or disinfect your hands.
- After hand hygiene go straight to your class.

Inside the school building:

- When moving through the school, face masks must be worn.
- Wash your hands regularly throughout the day.
- When coughing or sneezing cover your mouth and nose with a tissue or the crook of your elbow.
- Keep your distance! (minimum 1 meter)
- Do not shout or run (beware of breathing hygiene).

In the classroom:

- Before entry wash your hands.
- Open the windows regularly (at least once per hour for five minutes).
- When coughing or sneezing cover your mouth and nose with a tissue or the crook of your elbow.
- Stay in your assigned seat.
- Keep your distance! (minimum 1 meter)
